Racing Details:

Final groupings will be determined once all registrations have been received. Track is 111 meters on an Olympic size sheet. Awards will be given based on placing within USS age range. However, groupings are based primarily on skater ability rather than age and gender so that, as much as possible, all skaters will have the opportunity to be competitive within their groups. Skaters in the same USS age range may skate in different grouping if the qualifying times indicate the skaters are significantly different in ability. In this case, the skaters in the higher grouping will automatically finish above the other skater. Qualifying times are considered to be qualifications times for the grouping. Final groupings are at the sole discretion of the competition director.

Qualifying Time:

Provide a qualifying time for a 1000M when available. If a 1000M time is not available, provide a time for another distance. Also provide the competition name and date the qualifying time is from in case verification is needed. Try to submit a time from the last 12 months. If a qualifying time is not available, estimate your time in a 1000M and have your coach sign that this time is reflective of your abilities. Please submit a time that is reflective of your true abilities so that race groupings can be as accurate as possible.

Required Equipment:

Helmet, gloves, long sleeves, neck protection, knee pads and shin guards.

Races:

500, 1000, 1500

1500/3000 Super Final, relays if time allows, and/or skill/rodeo races as time allows
Younger or Novice age groups will have shorter races

Directions:

Colorado Springs is located at the intersection of I-25 and US-24 in central Colorado, approx. 60 miles south of Denver.

From I-25: I-25 to Circle Drive/Rt-29 exit 138. West on Circle Drive/Rt-29 to Venetucci Blvd. (second light). South (left) on Venetucci approx. 1/4 mile to Bob Johnson Dr. East (left) on Bob Johnson Dr. The World Arena Ice Hall is on the left.
